



ADDING VALUE WITH RENZ WIRE BINDING...

Book Binding




Most common cover style. Separate front and back covers. Opens easily back to back.

Half Canadian



The partially hidden wire is exposed on the back cover. The flat spine allows/makes the book easy to identify.

Reverse Binding




The binding is hidden and the spine is flat. The back flap can be glued down or left free.

Pocket Binding



The wire bound insert is designed to slip into the cover sleeve.

Full Canadian



The partially hidden wire is exposed on the front and back cover. The flat spine allows/makes the book easy to identify.

Cased In




Standard wire glued into a hard case offering all the related advantages.

Semi-Exposed




One piece wrap-around cover with a permanent look. Binding appears on the spine of the book.

Glued Back



A wire bound insert is pasted inside one piece, flat spine cover. The binding is concealed and the spine can be printed on.

Publisher



One-piece cover style that opens in reverse, creating a flat spine for easy identification.

Calendar

A wire bound calendar with or without a hanger.



Tent Card

A free-standing triangular cover. Pages flip over. Opens easily back to back.
